Brian has established a private careers consultancy business based in the Illawarra called *eCareers Academy*, with clients ranging from high school and university students to people re-entering the workforce and corporate employees in transition. He is also the founder and CEO of a corporate training organisation, *Empowering Training Solutions*.

Brian remains a strong supporter of UOW, and has volunteered to promote his old University on recent trips to Canada and France, encouraging students to consider Wollongong as a Study Abroad option. As an Illawarra community member, he is also involved in UOW's Networking After 5 activities and Entrepreneur Club events.
